Gentlemen:

Two Pipe Line Operations employees, Mr. Ramon J. Griego, Yardman and Mr. Ronald L. Knight, Maintenceman, have requested a temporary change in their normal work hours of 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. for approximately three days during the week of April 26, 1976. Both of these employees have been assigned the task of painting a swimming pool at Hinkley. If this work is done during the normal work hours, the fumes from the paint and the high temperature at Hinkley would cause discomfort.

Company is in agreement with the requested change in hours and accordingly proposes, pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, to temporarily change the hours for these two employees in the manner outlined above.

It is our understanding that the Union Business Representative serving Pipe Line Operations is in accord with this proposal.
