When Station A in Stockton Division was automated in 1975, additional Division Operator positions were added because of the increased work load in the Division Operators' Office. Since that time, the work schedule for the Office has been discussed with the Union locally. These discussions led to the attached proposal. Accordingly, Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, to adopt the attached schedule.

As indicated on the attached, the G schedule is the critical "OK" Desk which requires the most experienced operator. Therefore, Company further proposes that Schedule G be assigned to the qualified operator who has the most Stockton Division Operators' Office time.
