Gentlemen:

It is expected that soon after November 1, 1952 the second unit at Salt Springs Power House will be placed in operation. In the past, with a single unit operating, the personnel at the Power House has consisted of a Chief Operator and three First Operators, the First Operators being paid under Schedule IV. When the second unit is placed in operation a Foreman will be placed in charge of the Power House and the operating personnel will consist of four First Operators.

It is proposed that the First Operators' rate of \$78.20 per week under Schedule IV be changed to \$84.98 per week under Schedule II.
