Gentlemen:

As you know, the majority of routine maintenance work on Company's microwave installations is performed on Saturday in order to avoid interruptions in our communications networks.

In order to provide proper training for the Apprentice Communication Technicians in Stockton Division, Company proposes that for ~~one year~~ ^{SIX MONTHS RTW} during the two and one-half year apprenticeship, each Apprentice Communication Technician in Stockton Division be assigned a Tuesday through Saturday basic workweek. Company will give the apprentice involved as much notice of an impending change to Tuesday through Saturday workweek as possible, but in no case less than two weeks. *RTW*
