Gentlemen:

The wage rate of \$75.55 per week for the Utilityman classification in the Electric Department at Rio Vista, currently held by Mr. L. E. Frates, was computed on the basis of the following duties: Transformer Repairman 15%, Garageman 45%, Groundman 15%, Helper 10%, Laborer 15%.

Based upon a resurvey of the duties of this classification, Company proposes to establish the rate of \$76.25 per week based on the following breakdown:

Transformer Repairman	5% of \$82.15 or \$ 4.11
Truck Driver-Heavy (Boat Operation)	15% of \$82.15 or \$12.32
Helper	10% of \$73.90 or \$ 7.39
Garageman	45% of \$76.60 or \$34.47
Groundman	15% of \$73.90 or \$11.08
Laborer	<u>10%</u> of <u>\$68.40</u> or <u>\$ 6.84</u>
Utilityman	100% \$76.21
