On April 1, 1953 Company submitted a proposed letter agreement to increase the weekly wage rate of the Utilityman classification at Tiger Creek Power House in Stockton Division from \$76.27 to \$78.75. You did not accept such proposal. General increases and adjustments which have been made since the date of our proposal would bring the latter rate to \$85.35.

Company proposes that such Utilityman classification be established at the wage rate of \$85.35 per week with the following breakdown of duties: Station Attendant-West Point Power House 30%, Warehouseman 15%, Clerk C 15%, Flume Repairman 15%, and Apprentice Lineman 25%. The job is currently held by Mr. A. G. Jonas.
