Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter agreement establishing the classification of Utility Fitter - Monterey, dated January 29, 1957, is hereby withdrawn.

Company has recently completed a survey of the Utilityman classification currently held by Mr. R. H. Hommel in the Gas Department at Monterey. The components of this job are Fitter 54%, Apprentice Serviceman 28%, Chartman 18%, and the present wage rate is \$95.40 per week.

Company proposes to reclassify Mr. Hommel to Utility Fitter, with the following job definition:

Utility Fitter - Gas Department - Monterey

An employee who performs the work of a Fitter in the Gas Transmission and Distribution Department and who, in addition, may be required to perform the duties of a Chartman in the Gas Service Department and change gas meters and relight customers' pilots in connection therewith, lock meters, work change party tags and repair meters in the field by replacing damaged indices, glasses, etc.

This employee shall accrue classification seniority as a Fitter in the Gas Transmission and Distribution Department.

Wage rate: \$96.60 per week.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
