Gentlemen:

The Company finds it necessary to establish the elassification of Inspector in its Electric Department Office, San Francisco Division. It is therefore proposed that the wage rate which applies for Inspector, Electric Department Office, East Bay Division, that is \$76.67 per week, also be made applicable for San Francisco Division.

A definition of the duties of the Inspector classification for both San Francisco and East Bay Divisions is as follows:

INSPECTOR

An employee who is engaged in inspecting new construction and reconstruction work on overhead or underground lines; makes investigations such as checking Company property conditions in vicinity of street work, inquiring into accidents resulting in interruptions to service; etc.; contacts customers regarding service also for the purpose of making shutdown arrangements for cutovers; checks facilities with respect to necessary maintenance.
