Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter of agreement dated December 13, 1954 relative to the Utilityman classification in the Electric Department at San Mateo is hereby withdrawn.

In order to accomplish the routine maintenance work in the Substations in the San Mateo District of San Jose Division, Company proposes to establish the classification of Utilityman for that District with a weekly wage rate of \$85.50. The breakdown of duties of the proposed classification is as follows:

Electrician	42%	of \$96.80	or \$40.656
Rough Carpenter	15%	of \$78.55	or \$11.783
Labor Foreman	8%	of \$81.30	or \$ 6.504
Helper	35%	of \$75.75	or \$26.513
Utilityman	100%		\$85.456
