Dear Mr. Mason:

Due to the enlargement of Shasta Substation, we propose, effective May 1, 1947, to increase the rate of pay of the First Operators at the Station from \$60.80 to \$64.40 per week, or rerate the Station from Schedule III to II.

It is also proposed to have Second Operators on shift at this Station, and in order that this may be accomplished by May 1, 1947, the jobs are being listed in the Employment Bulletin for April.

Please advise if these changes meet with your approval.

Dear Mr. Tilson:

In reply to your letter of March 26th in which you propose to raise the Shasta Substation from Schedule III to Schedule II bringing the rate of first operator to \$64.40 per week and establish a classification of second operator on each shift, I might say that we feel there is a possibility that this may become a switch-center and inasmuch as switch-centers throughout the system have come under Schedule I classification, we might feel that at a later date that this station should be reclassified.

However, on the basis at the present time as outlined in your letter, you may use this letter as our approval of your proposal.
