Gentlemen:

Confirming our earlier conversations on this subject, Company will place Mr. William R. Reagan in a Clerk Driver vacancy in Richmond under the provisions of Section 209.9 of the Agreement, dated September 1, 1952, as amended.

Since it is expected that Mr. Reagan's disability is of a temporary nature, Company proposes under the provisions of Section 205.19 that Mr. Reagan be promoted to Fitter without further bid at such time as Dr. Charles Mell removes the physical restrictions which he has presently placed on Mr. Reagan. Upon such promotion, Mr. Reagan would not displace another employee, and the number of Fitters in his headquarters would be increased by one until a vacancy occurs in the normal course of events.
