Gentlemen:

Company has reviewed the rate per mile paid to employees under the provisions of Section 301.11 of the Agreement as a result of discussion between Company and Union in a General Construction Joint Grievance Committee meeting.

Recent fare increases by the major bus line in our service area has brought their average rate per mile to 3.68¢, with a minimum fare of 35¢ for short trips.

Therefore, Company proposes to amend the letter agreement of June 21, 1967 on this same subject to provide reimbursement at 3.7¢ per mile rather than 3½¢.

Further, Company intends to apply the 3.7¢ per mile rate in the reimbursement of employees under the provisions of Sections 201.2(b) and 201.10 of the Agreement.

If you are in accord with the foregoing proposal and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
