Gentlemen:

Effective January 3, 1955 Company changed the dual classification of Relief First Operator-Relief Second Operator at Wishon Power House to Relief and Emergency Relief First Operator-Utilityman. This change was overlooked at the time that the changes were made at Kerckhoff Power House.

Company, therefore, proposes to establish the Utilityman portion of this classification and to establish the wage rate for such portion at \$83.65 per week based upon the following breakdown of duties:

Truck Driver-Light	33.3% of \$81.30 =	\$27.10
Tractor Driver-Light	33.3% of \$81.30 =	\$27.10
Mechanic	<u>33.4%</u> of \$88.35 =	<u>\$29.45</u>
Utilityman	100 %	\$83.65
