Gentlemen:

Our letter agreement of January 22, 1969 provided for the transfer of certain clerical classifications represented by Union from the San Leandro office to Hayward. The letter agreement further provided for the reclassification of certain persons to Customer Service Clerk in the new Hayward facility.

It is our understanding that two of the employees initially reclassified to Customer Service Clerk, N. J. Johnson and C. A. Cozzo, had previously spent considerable time upgraded temporarily to Clerk C while assigned to a customer phone desk. As a result of the reclassification, they have not been given recognition for the periods that they were temporarily upgraded to such work.

The Company proposes an addendum to our letter agreement to provide that these two clerks be given wage progression consideration for this temporary upgraded time.

If you are in accord with the foregoing proposal and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
