Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter agreement dated May 21, 1969 with respect to Oakland Power Plant is hereby withdrawn.

Due to the shutdown of Oakland Power Plant and the removal of the responsibilities for the electrical operation of that Plant, Company is eliminating the classification of First Operator, Oakland Power Plant, and proposes to establish the classification of First Operator, Station "C" in Schedule I, effective July 1, 1969.

Under the provisions of Section 206.13, Company proposes to reclassify the First Operators and Emergency Relief First Operators at Oakland Power Plant to First Operator (or Emergency Relief First Operator as appropriate), Station "C."

In addition, the classification of Assistant First Operator at Oakland Power Plant will no longer be needed and Company will discontinue the classification, effective July 1, 1969. Company will establish the classification of Second Operator on that same date at Station "C." The placement of Assistant First Operators will be handled in accordance with the provisions of Title 206 of the physical Agreement.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
