Gentlemen:

By letter agreement dated October 5, 1965, a test procedure was established to determine employees' qualifications for promotion to vacancies in any of the Electrician classifications under the provisions of Section 205.11 of the Agreement.

This procedure was applied to automatic progression under the provisions of our letter agreement dated March 10, 1967.

Company at this time proposes that an employee who entered or will enter any of the Apprentice Electrician classifications in the Divisions on or after December 10, 1966 and who remains in such classification until he has completed 30 months in the classification will not be required to meet the above test requirements. However, the provisions of Section 205.11 shall remain applicable.

Company proposes the above change be effective on December 10, 1969.
