The Review Committee has recently discussed grievances that concern the proper wage rate of a Foreman's Clerk while directing the work of more than two Assistant Foreman's Clerks.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 204.4 of the current Physical Labor Agreement, Company proposes the following wage rates for Foreman's Clerk while directing the work of more than two Assistant Foreman's Clerks. The applicable wage rate for each such assignment shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of Section 204.5.

Start	-	\$181.55	per week
End 6 Mos.	-	\$186.40	" "
End 1 Yr.	-	\$191.30	" "
End 18 Mos.	-	\$196.20	" "

It is further agreed and understood that the foregoing wage rates shall become applicable on the execution of this letter agreement.
