Gentlemen:

Effective June 1, 1959, Company proposes to modify the Lines of Progression for the Water Department found on page 6 of Exhibit VI-G to provide that Water Treatment Plant Operator, Schedule I and II, be considered as the same classification for bidding purposes. Company further proposes to modify footnote 2 to read as follows:

"Water Servicemen shall be considered as Water Treatment Plant Operators III for bidding to Water Treatment Plant Operator I, II or III."

The purpose of this change is to permit employees classified as Water Treatment Plant Operator III to be considered as being in the next lower classification to Water Treatment Plant Operator I in Divisions where no Water Treatment Plant Operator II is employed.
