Dear Mr. Weakley:

Within the next two or three months the Company expects to complete the conversion of Petaluma Substation in North Bay Division from a manually operated to an automatic substation.

At the same time Ignacio Substation, also in North Bay Division, will be made a fully attended switching center and changed from its present unattended status.

The decision to discontinue substation operators at Petaluma Substation and establish operators at Ignacio Substation was made in order to improve our service in the Marin district.

It is proposed to establish the classification of first operator for Ignacio Substation and to establish a rate identical to that paid to first operators at substations of similar size and operation. Cordelia Substation and Mendocino Substation in North Bay Division are comparable stations.

The rate for first operator at the above enumerated substations is \$80.12 per week. Accordingly, it is proposed that the first operator's rate at Ignacio Substation be established at \$80.12 per week.
