Gentlemen:

The Company requires the services of a qualified journeyman, both as a machinist and electrician, to perform maintenance work in its Department of Gas Supply and Transmission. It is proposed therefore to discontinue the classification of Machinist, wage rate \$75.25 per week, as currently appearing in the effective Wage Schedule for such Department and supersede it by the classification of Electrical Machinist, wage rate \$77.00 per week.

The new classification wage rate and job definition will be the same as that applicable for the classification of Electrical Machinist in the Electric Maintenance Department.

If you are in accord with the above proposal please indicate acceptance on the duplicate copy of this letter and return same to the Company in order that a record be made of such agreement pending formal execution of a contract thereon.
