For the reason given below, Company proposes that Wage Schedule II, \$69.20 per week, for First Operators at Shasta Substation (three shift substation) be discontinued and that Wage Schedule I, \$70.65 per week, become effective in lieu thereof on June 1, 1948.

The responsibilities of the First Operators at Shasta Substation have increased inasmuch as further facilities have been placed in operation at that location.
