Gentlemen:

As a result of our recent negotiations with respect to job definitions and lines of progression in the Division Garage Departments including the Department of Pipe Line Operations, Company proposes the following:

1. To establish the classification of Parts Clerk with a wage range of \$87.70 to \$96.60 per week.
2. Discontinue the classifications of Welder and Machinist as the present incumbents vacate such jobs.
3. Abolish the classification of Helper and reclassify Garage Department Helpers to Garageman.
4. Change the wage progression of the Garageman classification to the following:

Start	\$ 77.90 per week
End 6 months	79.30 " "
End 1 year	82.15 " "
End 18 months	84.95 " "
