Gentlemen:

Due to the effect on Mr. C. L. Shattuck's health, the Company has found it necessary to remove him from his position as a Senior Terminal Operator at Kettleman. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 206.13 of the current Agreement, Company proposes to place Mr. Shattuck in a vacant Oiler classification at Kettleman and notwithstanding any other provision of Titles 205 and 206, he shall have the right only to return to a Senior Terminal Operator position at Kettleman provided he is then capable of demonstrating his ability to perform those duties.

Our proposal to place Mr. Shattuck in the Oiler classification has been discussed with your Business Representative, Mr. F. W. Weaver, and your office. Inasmuch as they concur with the proposal, Mr. Shattuck was placed in the Oiler classification at Kettleman on March 28, 1970.
