Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes our letter dated June 4, 1970 on the same subject.

Company plans to move ten Overhead Line classifications from Concord to Antioch and Walnut Creek as follows:

- Antioch - (2) Line Subforemen, (1) Lineman,
(3) Apprentice Linemen
- Walnut Creek - (2) Linemen, (2) Apprentice Linemen

In accordance with Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to fill these vacancies, without reference to the bidding procedure outlined in Section 205.7 of the Physical Agreement, in the following manner:

These vacancies, at Antioch and Walnut Creek, will be filled by selecting the most senior qualified employees from Concord who indicate a desire to be placed into the classifications and locations listed above.

In the event that Company cannot fill the above vacancies on a voluntary basis, they will be filled as provided in Title 206 of the Physical Agreement.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
