The present Relief First Operator at Morro Bay Switching Center works a schedule of 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Company is establishing a second Relief First Operator position at that location and proposes, under the provisions of Subsection 202.16(b) of the Agreement, to establish the hours of work of this second position to be from 12:00 noon to 8:00 PM.

When the second position is filled, Company further proposes that the two Relief First Operators will exchange shifts on a four-week rotation. Further, if the complement at Morro Bay Switching Center changes, the 12:00 noon to 8:00 PM shift will be subject to review.

It is our understanding that Mr. Mark Cook, Union Business Representative, is in accord with this proposal.
