Gentlemen:

This letter agreement cancels and supersedes our proposal to you on the same subject dated December 3, 1970.

Mr. B. J. Coffey, Apprentice Electrician (red-circle) in the San Francisco Electric T and D Underground Construction Department, has been for some time performing duties as an assistant to a Senior Meterman in the Division Electric Meter Shop.

Accordingly, Company proposes to establish the classification of Utility Meterman on a present incumbent only basis and to assign Mr. Coffey to this classification under the provisions of Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement. Company further proposes that Mr. Coffey's present wage rate of \$179.60 be maintained until such rate is met or exceeded by the top rate of the Shop Meterman classification, at which time his rate as a Utility Meterman shall be maintained equivalent to the Shop Meterman maximum.

The proposed definition for this position is:

Utility Meterman

An employee who assists a Senior Meterman change, install and remove self-contained meters, both single phase and polyphase A-base and socket type. Assists the Senior Meterman verify meter locations in multi-occupancy residential and commercial buildings. Assists Senior Meterman on instrument transformer installations where a second man is required. Also may assist in the Meter Shop, handling meters when needed and the volume of field work permits. Performs necessary associated paper work as directed.
