Dear Mr. Mason:

We have reviewed the duties and responsibilities of the operators at the Kern Oil Substation and are recommending that the station be re-rated from a Group IV station with a rate of \$58.30 per week to Group III with a rate of \$60.80 per week effective July 1, 1947.

In making our recommendation consideration was given to the service calls which they receive at night, the installation of an additional synchronous condenser as well as the additional equipment which will be added to this station upon completion of the Kern Steam Plant.
