In May 1971 all overhead and underground distribution transformers in San Francisco Division will be assigned for maintenance to the Substation Maintenance Section of the District Electric Department and the classification of Transformer Repairman (2140) established in the Division. As a result, Company proposes under Section 204.4 of the Physical Agreement to eliminate the San Francisco Division classification of Shopman (2260) and to assign Mr. J. W. Friedle, Shopman in the Division, to a Transformer Repairman classification under the provisions of Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Physical Agreement.
