Gentlemen:

Company will eliminate the classification of Ditch Patrolman (\$113.65 - \$120.50 per week) at Camp 1 in the Hydro Department in De Sabla Division and will establish in its stead the classification of Ditch Tender (\$115.60 - \$123.75 per week).

Under the provisions of Subsection 206.1(e), Company proposes to reclassify Mr. Marion Bennum, incumbent Ditch Patrolman, to Ditch Tender at the top of the wage progression (\$123.75 per week) without reference to the bidding procedure.

Company proposes such reclassification be effective on the date agreement is reached between Company and Union on this matter.
