Confirming Company-Union discussions concerning instrument repair classifications for use in the Steam Plants, the Company proposes the following:

(1) The classification of Instrument Repairman will be established, the wage rate and jeb definition of such classification to be:

INSTRUMENT REPAIRMAN: (Steam Plants)

A journeyman classification for an employee who has ecompleted his training as Apprentice Instrument Repairman and whose principal duties are to maintain, service and calibrate automatic control equipment, instruments and gages. Duties require the use of machine and bench tools in connection with the maintenance and repair of automatic control equipment and instruments. Duties may also include assisting the Test Engineer in taking readings during plant tests, tabulating and charting test data.

Wage rate:

\$86,60 per week.

(2) The job definition and wage rate for the classification of Apprentice Instrument Repairman to apply in Steam Plants shall be amended as follows:

APPRENTICE INSTRUMENT REPAIRMAN: (Steam Plants)

An employee engaged in performing repair work on instrument and controls as an assistant to and under the supervision of the Instrument Repairman; may work alone with tools and machines requiring moderate skill and accuracy; in training for advancement to an Instrument Repairman upon completion of apprenticeship and when an opening occurs. May also be required to assist the Test Engineer on non-technical assignments such as taking readings during plant tests, tabulating and charting test data, and technical filing. Must be at least a high school graduate or have the equivalent education. Classification seniority not exceeding eighteen months shall be credited in the Apprentice Machinist classification for job bidding purposes.
