Gentlemen:

Company will eliminate a Cable Splicer and an Apprentice Cable Splicer from the underground crew headquartered in San Jose and will establish one position each of Cable Splicer and Apprentice Cable Splicer at Cupertino.

Under the provisions of Section 206.1(e) of the Agreement, Company proposes to transfer Mr. G. A. MacKenzie, Cable Splicer, and Mr. W. Thomason, Apprentice Cable Splicer, from San Jose to Cupertino without reference to the bidding procedure. Mr. MacKenzie and Mr. Thomason will receive preferential consideration on bids to return to the San Jose headquarters in the future under the provisions of Section 206.9(a) of the Agreement.
