Gentlemen:

During the September and November Grievance Meetings for General Construction, the subject of a classification between that of Field Garageman and Field Mechanic-B was discussed. As a result of these discussions and our studies of the situation, Company proposes to establish a classification of Field Mechanic-C with the following wage rate:

Start - \$129.00 per week
End 6 months - \$135.00 per week

This classification will apply to employees who drive the lubrication trucks. Such employees will, of course, be engaged in providing lubrication, gasoline and oil for all types of vehicles and construction equipment in the field. They would also make minor repairs and adjustments to such equipment without direct supervision.
