Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes our letter to you dated November 2, 1978, on the same subject.

Coast Valleys Division is in the process of establishing a gas load center in Salinas to monitor the operation of the Division's gas system. The load center will be manned 16 hours per day, Monday through Saturday, primarily dispatching service work to Gas Servicemen. Approximately 6% of the time the operators will be monitoring pressure from eight sensing locations and responding to audio pressure alarms by notifying the appropriate supervisor. The load center personnel will not routinely transmit pressures to Gas Control.

After discussion with your administrative staff, Company proposes, pursuant to Title 600, Exhibit VI, of the Physical Labor Agreement, to allow the Gas Service Operators and Relief Service Operators headquartered in Salinas to man the load center and perform the Pressure Operator job duties mentioned above.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
