Gentlemen:

In 1978, when the Gas and Electric Office Clerks at Colma were consolidated and their classifications changed to Clerk-Operating, an unintended result was the removal of the Clerk "C" - Electric from the line of progression to First Plant Clerk, Steam Electric Generation Department. Hence, the Colma Operating Clerks lost their 205.7(b) bidding rights to First Plant Clerk, Steam Generation, that they previously had as Clerk "C" - Electric.

Therefore, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Labor Agreement, Company proposes to include Operating Clerks headquartered in Colma in the line of progression to Power Plant Clerk classifications.
