Company will have an insulator wiping program again this summer; however, since the proposed General Construction Master Apprenticeship Agreement precludes temporary upgrades to the classification, Company proposes to establish the following classification and rate of pay to be used, for temporary purposes only, to provide assistance for this year's program:

2639 - Insulator Wiper - \$316.70 per week
