Gentlemen:

Mr. R. L. Kendall, Clerk C, Gas Department, Petaluma, was given bidding rights to a Gas Service Operator's classification either in San Rafael or Santa Rosa by letter agreement dated July 19, 1977. At that time, there was no Service Operator classification in Petaluma and the letter agreement was limited to the headquarters mentioned above. As a result of a Division Study concerning the Petaluma Operating Clerical Department, Company is in the process of establishing a Gas Service operator classification in Petaluma and, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.12 of the Physical Labor Agreement, Company proposes to place Mr. Kendall in the vacancy.

It is our understanding that the Business Representative, Frank Saxsenmeier, concurs with this proposal.
