Confirming discussion in the meeting of August 7, 1951, at which time the duties of the South Tower Substation First Operator classification were discussed, it is proposed effective September 1, 1951, to amend the basic wage schedule as follows:

Operator, First-East Bay Division	
Stations	\$81.72 per week
Add South Tower	
Stations	\$80.12
Delete South Tower	

The foregoing proposal, negotiated on the basis of increased duties assigned to the Station, upgrades the South Tower First Operator classification to a level equal to Stations Contra Costa, Contra Costa Steam Plant Switching Station, "D", "F", "H", "L", Moraga and "X".
