Gentlemen:

During the recently completed negotiations, Company and Union agreed to establish the classifications of Line Truck Driver and Senior Line Truck Driver with the following job definitions.

Line Truck Driver

An employee who drives a truck used by a line crew, maneuvers it at the job as required; operates all mechanical equipment on the truck (excluding a derrick and/or a mechanical hole digger); acts as field clerk performing assigned clerical work for the crew; is responsible for keeping materials and tools in good order on the truck; assists with ground work, and may be permitted to climb and work in training for advancement to Apprentice Lineman, if he so desires.

Senior Line Truck Driver

An employee who drives a truck used by a line crew, maneuvers it at the job as required, operates all mechanical equipment on the truck; acts as field clerk performing assigned clerical work for the crew; is responsible for keeping materials and tools in good order on the truck; assists with ground work, and may be permitted to climb and work in training for advancement to Apprentice Lineman, if he so desires.

In addition, the lines of progression for the Electric Overhead Department are to be revised as shown in the attached sheet.
