Gentlemen:

During recently concluded negotiations the rate of pay for the Instrument Technician classification in General Construction was established at \$510.65 per week (see letter agreement signed October 22, 1979). At that time the rate established was the same as the Communication Technician in General Construction. During subsequent negotiations, certain General Construction adjustments were made which raised the Communication Technician to its present rate of \$513.40 per week.

In order to maintain the original wage relationship between the Communication Technician and the Instrument Technician classifications, Company proposes to adjust the Instrument Technician rate to \$513.40 per week effective on the date you sign this letter agreement.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
