Gentlemen:

The employees of the Division Building Department assigned to Chico District and headquartered at Chico have expressed a desire to change their regular working hours during the upcoming summer months. Company is willing to accommodate the wishes of its employees so long as goals of service, efficiency and equity do not suffer. Therefore, Company proposes, pursuant to Section 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, to establish work hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and from 12:00 noon to 3:30 p.m., starting the first Monday of May and ending the last Friday of September for Building Department employees headquartered at Chico. The workweek is to remain unchanged Monday through Friday. The Operating Clerk assigned to the Building Department is exempt from this schedule. It is intended that the Building Department employees will resume their normal work period of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. following this May through September hours schedule.

The proposed hours change has been discussed with the Union Business Representative for De Sabla Division, Mr. Richard M. Hafner, and has his concurrence.
