Gentlemen:

Company proposes, pursuant to Section 202.16 of the Physical Agreement, to change the hours of work for all Division Electric Meter Shop employees in Fresno coming under that Agreement, during the summer months of 1981. The proposed hours of work would be from 7:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 12:00 noon to 3:30 p.m. and would be in effect from Monday, June 1, 1981, through Friday, September 25, 1981. The balance of the year would have work hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. This change would provide more work performed in more comfortable temperatures.

Company also proposes, pursuant to Section 10.7(b) of the Clerical Agreement, to change the hours of work for one Division Electric Meter Shop Operating Clerk in Fresno from the present hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., to 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with an hour for lunch, for the summer period specified above. This allows for processing the day's magnetic tape recorder readings and tapes and mailing the readings to the General Office on the same day they are read.

This Agreement may be cancelled by either party upon giving 30 days' written notice to the other of such cancellation.
