Gentlemen:

Company proposes, pursuant to Section 10.7 of the Clerical Agreement, to temporarily change the work schedule of employees in the Production and Scheduling/Control Sections of the Computer Operations Department. For a six-month period beginning June 6, 1982, and ending December 6, 1982, this agreement will temporarily amend Letter Agreement No. 80-17-PGE, dated June 12, 1981, which established the current work schedule in the above-referenced work units.

The proposed temporary schedule is as follows:

<u>Shift</u>	<u>Work Week</u>	<u>Work Hours</u>
First	Sunday - Thursday	7:30 a.m. - 4:15 p.m.
Second	Sunday - Thursday	4:00 p.m. - 12:00 a.m.
Third	Sunday - Thursday	11:45 p.m. - 7:45 a.m.

It is expected that the composition of each shift will initially include one Console Operator, one Senior Computer Operator, and three Computer Operators or Computer Operators-in-Training, in the Production Section, and one Senior Computer Operator, and one Computer Operator or Computer Operator-in-Training in the Scheduling/Control Section. Company may add or delete Senior Computer Operators, Computer Operators, Console Operators, or Computer Operators-in-Training, as required by the type and amount of work to be performed on each shift.

This agreement may be cancelled at either party's option upon 30 days advance written notice.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to the Company.
