Gentlemen:

Mr. R. H. McKinney, Light Crew Foreman (0640), East Bay Division, suffered a back injury on February 3, 1981 and has been precluded from returning to that classification. Mr. McKinney has been working as an Operating Clerk, Gas Department, Walnut Creek, East Bay Division on light duty since March 29, 1982. His condition has been rated permanent and stationary.

Pursuant to Section 18.17 of the Clerical Agreement, Company proposes to place Mr. McKinney in a vacant Operating Clerk position in the Walnut Creek Gas Department. Mr. McKinney's 18 years of service entitle him to a weekly wage rate of \$589.55 pursuant to Subsection 7.10(b) of the Clerical Agreement.

It is our understanding that this proposal has the concurrence of Mr. McKinney, and Mr. Joseph Valentino, Union Business Representative.
