Gentlemen:

On June 13, 1983, Mr. Ernie D. Sierra, Yardman, Electric Operations-Kettleman, vacated this position due to his being awarded an Apprentice Transmission Mechanic position in Pipeline Operations.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 205.19 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to reclassify the Yardman classification (2640-incumbent only) to a Maintenceman classification (1160) in the Electric Operations line of progression.

Mr. Curtis Tally is currently holding a Utilityman position (2570) which was established in Electric Operations-Kettleman, in accordance with Letter Agreement R2-82-PGE of October 15, 1982. Accordingly, Company proposes to place Mr. Tally into this newly established Maintenceman classification. The Utilityman position thus vacated, will then be filled.
