In November 1977, certain changes were made in San Francisco Division Gas Department classifications. One of the changes agreed to was the elimination of the Manhole Mechanic classification. It has recently come to our attention that two employees, Mr. N. J. Beyk and Mr. P. L. Trijillo, have continued to be classified as Manhole Mechanics on a permanent basis.

As these employees have been and will continue to be productive in their present Manhole Mechanic classification, the Company proposes to maintain these employees in their Manhole Mechanic positions on a present incumbent only basis. The Company also proposes that Mr. Beyk and Mr. Trijillo be allowed to prebid to the position of 0641 - Light Crew Foreman, non-welding.
