Gentlemen:

Mr. Ivan E. McGee was employed by the Company on October 4, 1965. On April 1, 1978 he was placed on LTD from his position as Materials Leadman in San Francisco Division, General Services Department. He returned to work August 9, 1978, on a trial basis, as a Clerk D in Customer Services. He was temporarily upgraded to Customer Services Clerk on August 21, 1978, placed on the Compensation Payroll December 18, 1978, and returned to LTD effective August 1, 1979. Mr. McGee has now been released by his doctor to return to work.

Company proposes, pursuant to Section 112.15 of the Physical Agreement, to return Mr. McGee to a vacant Materialsman position in San Francisco Division General Services Department. Pursuant to Subsection 112.10(c), Mr. McGee's rate of pay will be \$547.00 per week. The proposal has been discussed with the local Union Representative.
