Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Subsection 204.7(b) of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to waive the placement of Mr. E. H. Sweet into the Apprentice Meterman classification in accordance with paragraph G10(c) of the Master Apprenticeship Agreement. Mr. Sweet was previously an Apprentice Lineman, Lineman and Line Subforeman.

As we propose, Mr. Sweet would be placed at the six-month wage step immediately as he has passed Basic Electricity. He would then progress through the apprenticeship and complete it in a total of thirty months.
