We propose to extend the Ad Hoc Switching Committee Negotiations for a 30-day period. Both Company and Union Ad Hoc Committees have agreed to this proposed extension.

The Committees are basically in agreement on the revised language to the Job Definitions concerning the classifications involved as well as the system-wide standard training program. The salary issue, however, could not be resolved on June 27, 1984.


