Gentlemen:

Company has received a request from the Computer Operations Department regarding the substitution of a holiday day in place of the currently provided Independence Day Holiday.

The third-shift employees (Computer Operators) in the Computer Operations Department work the hours of 11:45 p.m. to 7:30 a.m., and the Independence Day Holiday for these employees is currently observed on their normal work shift of Tuesday, July 3, from 11:45 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. July 4.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 14.1 of the Clerical Agreement, and based on the unanimous request of the 18 Computer Operators in the Computer Operations Department, Company proposes to substitute the day of July 4 from 11:45 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. as the observed Independence Day Holiday for the above-named employees. Under this Agreement, these employees will then be required to work their normal shift on Tuesday, July 3. Furthermore, this Agreement shall not result in any overtime or holiday payments unless otherwise necessitated by a change in schedule.

This proposal has been discussed in detail with Ms. Dorothy Fortier, Local Business Representative.
