Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the provisions established in Letter of Agreement 84-50 (Meter Reader Settlement), Company proposes, at the request of the Meter Readers, to deviate from route string bidding as follows: In the Hollister office to rotate monthly, in the Salinas office to rotate every two months, in the Monterey office to rotate every three months, in the San Luis Obispo office to rotate every six months, and in the King City office, rotation will vary. Meter Readers in the Paso Robles office will remain on present routes for remainder of the year. The Meter Readers in the above-named offices voted and agreed upon, by a majority vote, these proposals.
